

TRAVEL TO THE WEST PARK CENTRE FROM DUNDEE

By train:

The West Park Centre is approximately one mile from the centre of Dundee and the railway station for the city.

By taxi:

A taxi journey from the railway station to the venue will take about 5-minutes and should cost approximately £3.00 - £4.00.

By bus:

Please note that the buses are infrequent. Walk through the covered overpass from the Railway Station, and you arrive in the City Centre. From Whitehall St, you can catch a No. 16, which runs once every hour for 80 pence. (If you arrive on the Sunday, it runs once every two hours.) From Union St, you can catch a 76, which runs every 30 minutes (but not at all on a Sunday) for approximately the same fare.

By car:

We recommend coming down Riverside Drive, following signs for the City Centre, all the way to the main roundabout near the Railway Station. Follow the signs marked for the University, and at your first main junction, turn left up the Nethergate, which becomes the Perth Road and takes you past the University of Dundee. Continue along Perth Rd until you come to the West Park Conference Centre, on your right. There is plenty of parking available and no permits are required.

By foot:

It is a long walk to the West Park Centre from the railway station, but if you are feeling energetic, it is sunny and your bag is light, it will take about 45 minutes to walk.
