

# **Target Localisation in Multistatic Pulse-Doppler Radar**

Radar is an often unintuitive sensing modality, which has lots of interesting measurement errors to consider in a statistical setting. Here we discuss the Bayesian inference problem of recovering position and velocity information about a compact moving target from imprecise multistatic radar measurements, and then discuss the impact this has on attempts to track multiple targets simultaneously.
